# Release Notes Storyteller v3.0


This document provides an overview of the new features and enhancement requests that were implemented in this release, and describes any important upgrade advisories and resolved issues. It also outlines the known issues, and workarounds if applicable, that you may experience while using Storyteller v3.0.



#### What's New

- This release, Storyteller got a makeover. The new refreshed UI is more modern, streamlined, and intuitive, with improved consistency, visual appeal, and user-centricity. Changes include the main toolbar now being contained within the Explorer, and various artifact toolbar actions now being more visible and quickly accessible. Additionally, all global actions and Utility Panel shortcuts remain exposed when the Explorer and the Utility Panel are collapsed.
- The new Collection View displays all the artifacts in your Collection as a table with customizable
  columns, allowing you to easily view, organize, and edit large sets of data. You can now use Collections to
  create multiple workspaces once configured, your Collection View will be saved for you individually.






• We've added the ability to create Follow-Up Reviews. The newly-created Review artifact is prepopulated with details from the original Review that was sent out – all artifacts, participants, and settings are kept the same (but can be updated by the Review Manager). The latest versions of all artifacts will be brought over. Unchanged artifacts will keep their same approval statuses.



The Review Experience has been updated to include filtering based on Review Status. Approvers can
now easily view all approved or disapproved artifacts, as well as any artifacts still needing their approval.
The Review Summary Header has also been improved for added clarity.

- We've added **Webhooks** to Storyteller triggered by certain events, they then send artifact information to a URL that can be consumed or interpreted by receiving applications. This release, Webhooks are present in the form of a **new action type in Workflow**, which is configurable by XML.
- The REST API has been updated with the ability to create a project. Projects can be created as empty or based off an existing template.
- Instance Administrators can now specify the types of file attachments that can be uploaded to Blueprint by whitelisting certain uploadable file types in a specific project or instance.
- We've added support for Active Directory structure with trusted domains.
- Performance enhancements to Search now produce even faster results with an updated UI.

#### **Implemented Enhancement Requests**

The ER number is the enhancement request number. Searching for this number in the Blueprint Community will display the enhancement ID details.

- The new Collection View displays all the artifacts in your Collection as a table with customizable columns, allowing you to easily view, organize, and edit large sets of data (ER-1799).
- You can now use Collections to create multiple individual workspaces once configured, your Collection View will be saved (<u>ER-2409</u>).
- The Review Experience has been updated to include filtering based on Review Status. Approvers can now
  easily view all approved or disapproved artifacts, as well as any artifacts still needing their approval (ER1760).
- We've added the ability to create Follow-Up Reviews. The newly-created Review artifact is prepopulated with all artifacts, participants, and settings from the original Review (ER-1776).
- In the Review Experience, users are now able to change the approval status of a folder with all its
  contents. All children in the folder will be marked as approved, disapproved, or pending (<u>ER-1622</u>).
- The REST API has been updated with the ability to create a project. Projects can be created as empty or based off an existing template (<u>ER-2075</u>).
- We've added the ability to specify the types of file attachments that can be uploaded to Storyteller.
   Administrators can now whitelist certain file types for a particular instance. If no allowable file types are specified, the system will not restrict what can be uploaded (<u>ER-2102</u>).



#### **Resolved Issues**

The following issues were resolved for Storyteller v3.0:

- Internet Explorer users were experiencing longer wait times when loading a Workflow diagram with a high amount of states. A Refresh button has been added to the Workflow canvas in Internet Explorer (Issue #3945).
- Users making API calls to download an attachment were experiencing long wait times (Issue #7619).
- Running the PopulateSemanticSearch stored procedure was returning an error (Issue #9745).
- Users would get an error message when clicking "Save" in the Workflow canvas, when no changes were made (Issue #6610).
- Artifacts that are part of an Informal Review were being marked as unviewed in the Reviews metrics when they were updated after the Review was closed (Issue #6518).
- Some information was not being shown in the Review Experience when users were selecting a subartifact in a Process diagram (Issue #6068).
- When clicking "Back" from a Process, the browser would not immediately route to previous page. The
  previous page would only display after the second click (Issue #6069).

#### **Upgrade Advisories**

Please note the following advisories before proceeding with your product upgrade.

#### Blueprint and Storyteller Version Support

Later this year, for the Blueprint v9.1 release and the Storyteller v3.1 release, support will be terminated for the following Blueprint versions: 7.0, 7.1, 7.2, 7.3, and 7.4; and the following Storyteller versions: 1.0 and 1.1. If you have any questions or concerns, please reach out to the Blueprint Support Team

#### **Known Issues**

The following are known issues in Storyteller v3.0.

- The list of artifacts is reordered after changing artifacts' approval statuses through bulk actions in the Artifacts tab of a Review (Issue #10307).
  - **Workaround:** Publish the Review artifact after using bulk actions in the Artifacts tab.
- Actor inheritances and document references are not immediately displayed in the Utility Panel Relationships tab after being added (Issue #11349).
  - Workaround: Refresh, save, or publish the artifact.
- If the Utility Panel Relationships tab is open when adding a new actor or include to a Process sub-artifact, the new relationship is not displayed after saving or publishing the artifact (Issue #11349).
   Workaround: Deselect then reselect the shape.
- When attempting to open Impact Analysis with a sub-artifact selected, Impact Analysis instead opens the main artifact.
  - **Workaround:** Click the Source icon in Impact Analysis and input the sub-artifact ID. The selected sub-artifact ID can be found at the top of the Utility Panel.
